Arrival

We have a barrier on entry. Please use the CALL button to access the club.

There is ample parking onsite and we recommend that you park on the Visitors Car Park which is signed, and on the left as you drive in.

Booking In

Please try to arrive at least 40 minutes before your tee time and head to the Professional Shop to check in and pay green fees. Our score cards are available on the wall outside Reception (and can be viewed on our website) You will be advised of any local rules when checking in.

Dress code (On the Course)

Socks & golf shoes must be worn and shirts must have collars, and be tucked in.

Shorts must be tailored. No sports or cargo shorts, no jeans or football tops are allowed.

Dress code (Clubhouse)

Smart casual, no tracksuits/ football tops/ hats or spiked shoes will be allowed at any time.

Hire Items and Professional Services

NULGC Golf Pace of Play:

Pace of play guidelines are as follows:

- 2 ball 3 hours
- 3 ball 3 hours 20 minutes
- 4 ball 3 hours 40 minutes.

Please keep up with the group ahead and call fast groups through.

Please note that groups of 5 or more are not allowed.

Etiquette:

- ✓ Golfers must repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.
- ✓ Keep buggies and trolleys away from the tees and greens
- ✓ Play ready golf where possible
- ✓ Allow a faster moving group to play through if possible
- ✓ Always show kindness and respect to other golfers
- ✓ Our staff working on the course have priority, please wait for them to wave and indicate it's safe to play.
- ✓ Please note that mobile phones should not be used on the course, or in the Clubhouse.

Halfway house

Food and beverages can be ordered from the 8th tee and will be delivered to the halfway house or collection.

Practice Facilities

We have a putting green and chipping area near the clubhouse for all golfers to utilise during their time here at the club. There are nets available to warm up on the path to the 1st tee. There is small a practice area in the centre of the course. Please ask our team in the Professional Shop about availability.
